The objective of Koinno Consultancy is to increase the innovative strength of public procurement.

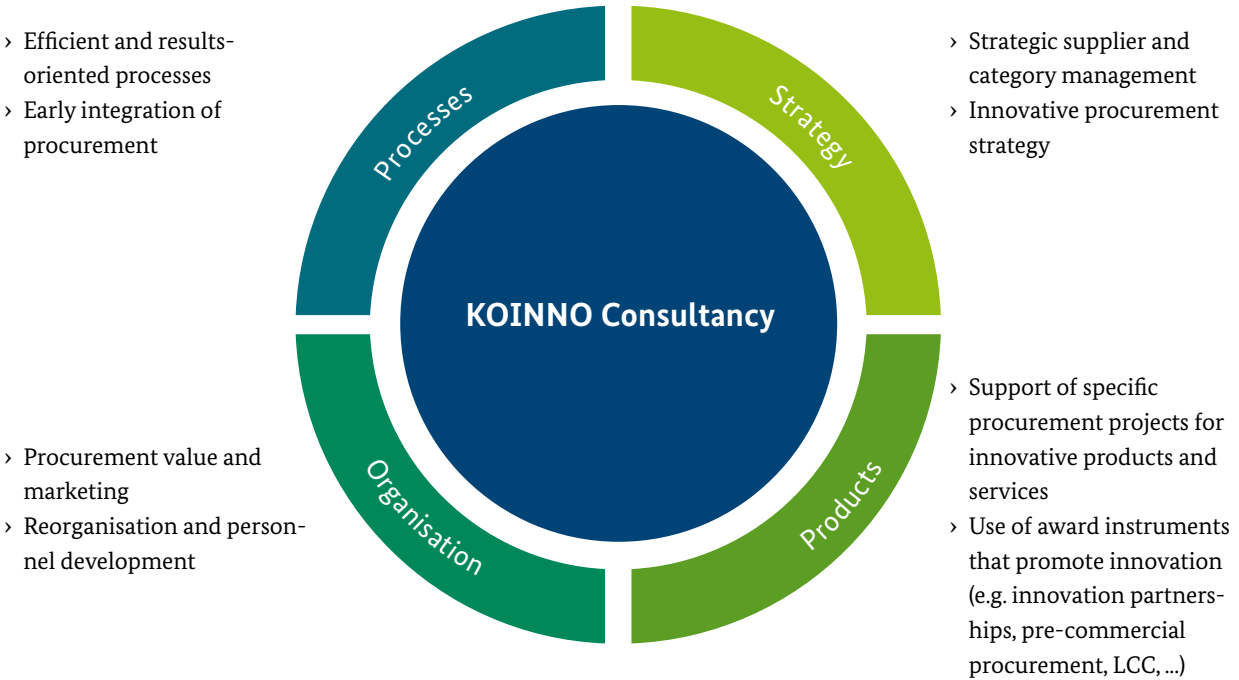
